WHAT DOES CANNABIS CORP DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

Why?	Cannabis companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.	
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Name and address• Date of birth• Sales transaction history When you are <i>no longer</i> our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.	
How?	In the section below, we list the reasons cannabis companies can share their customers' personal information, the reasons Cannabis Corp chooses to share, and whether you can limit this sharing.	
Reasons we can share your personal information	Does Cannabis Corp share?	Can you limit this sharing?
For our everyday business purposes – such as to process your transactions, verify you are of legal age to purchase cannabis products	No	We don't share
For our marketing purposes – to offer our products and services to you	No	We don't share
For joint marketing with other cannabis companies	No	We don't share
For our affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your transactions and experiences	No	We don't share
For non-affiliates to market to you	No	We don't share

What we do	
How does Cannabis Corp protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. Contracts with our service providers require them to restrict access to your non-public personal information, and to maintain physical electronic and procedural safeguards against unintended disclosure.
How does Cannabis Corp collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information when, as required by law, you present your government issued ID to shop in our stores.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Affiliates from using your information to market to you • Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership control. They can be cannabis or non-cannabis companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Cannabis Corp does not have any affiliates</i>
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership control. They can be cannabis or non-cannabis companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Cannabis Corp does not share information with non-affiliates</i>
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated cannabis companies that together market cannabis products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Cannabis Corp does not jointly market</i>
